Attention: First paycheck - **may take up to 3 weeks depending on the time of arrival**

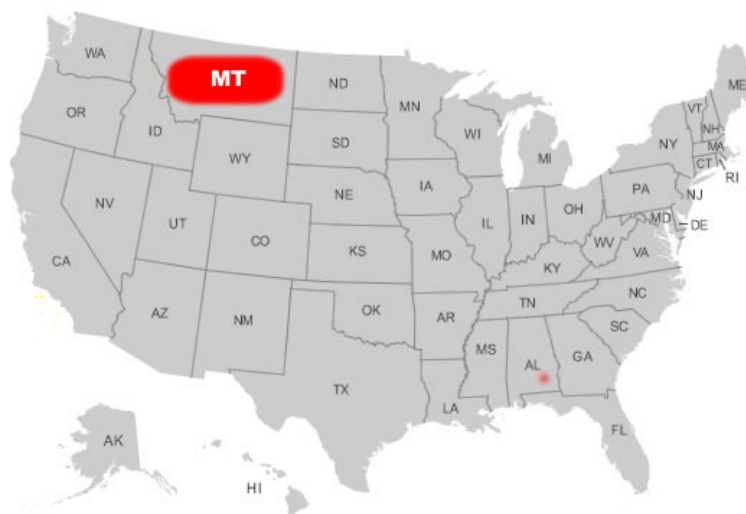

EMPLOYER'S NEEDS & EXPECTATIONS

Employers needs: Students, both males and females

Level of English required: **FLUENT** level of English. An English interview must be passed

Skills required: None

Available positions: **Bartender, Server, Cashier, Host, Front desk, Room attendant** in hotel. **The positions are determined by hotel management upon arrival and are NOT chosen by the students.**

Dress code: Students need to bring black shoes and black pants, black belt for pants. Shirts will be provided

HOUSING

Is employee housing available: YES

Housing description: Housing is **dormitory style** with a kitchen, large livingroom and a bathroom, 2-4 students will share a bedroom, depending on size, 2 to 6 to share the bathroom. There is a basic rental furniture provided (bed, table and chairs). All utilities with apartment, **no linens or kitchen utensils**

Housing deposit: \$100 refundable, less \$50 cleaning fee

Cost of housing: \$75/week — the sub-lease will have the same length as the DS-2019 Form. The minimum required time to be committed to the housing is 3 months. If after 3 months, but before the end of the DS-2019 a student wishes to depart, he/she must notify

Housing deposit & first month rent are due upon arrival (\$400)

ARRIVAL

Arrival pick-up provided: YES

On site transportation: Public transportation, walk, bicycle (\$80) or if HCMS provides it, the rate will be \$5/day

Arrival procedures: Students should arrive into Mobile, Alabama by plane or Greyhound bus, during the week and not after 5PM. The arrival details must be sent at least 10 days prior to arrival. If they arrive on the weekend or late at night, they are responsible to get a hotel until the next working day for pick up
